

Uniti Fiber – Frequently Asked Questions

Who is Uniti?

Uniti was established on April 24, 2015 as Communications Sales and Leasing, Inc. In February of 2017, we re-branded as the Uniti you see today. Initially we owned 3.5 million strand miles of fiber and our annual revenues were less than \$700 million.

Since that time, Uniti has invested over \$1.7 billion of capital to grow our business. In 2016 Uniti acquired PEG Bandwidth and Tower Cloud, merging the operations of the two organizations to create Uniti Fiber. In 2017 Uniti acquired Hunt and Southern Light, then added Information Transport Solutions in 2018. We also recently entered into sale lease-back transactions with TPx and CableSouth, as well as acquired fiber assets from CenturyLink. We now own 5.4 million strand miles of fiber and our annual revenue for 2018 is expected to be ~\$1.0 Billion.

Who is Uniti Fiber?

Uniti Fiber is a business unit of Uniti Group Inc. M² Connections now joins Uniti Fiber, firmly establishing the company's commitment to seamlessly connect communities large and small by providing the most advanced communication technologies available.

Who leads Uniti Fiber?

Uniti Fiber is led by Andy Newton, former Chief Executive Officer of Mobile, Alabama based Southern Light.

Where is Uniti Fiber located?

Uniti Fiber is headquartered in Mobile, Alabama and has offices near Tampa, Jacksonville (FL), Dallas, Birmingham, Jackson (MS), New Orleans, and Monroe (LA). Uniti Fiber also operates several network operations centers and colocation facilities.

Does this change where my bills are paid?

No, not initially. While there may be some consolidation of business groups within Uniti Fiber, for the near future you will continue to pay your bills as you have. If there are any changes, these will be communicated in advance and there will be a transition period.
